<i><b>Tuition Scholarship (Fee Waiver)</b></i>	<p>Louisiana residents may qualify for the TOPS program which pays full tuition.</p> <p>The School of Music Tuition Scholarship covers partial to full tuition (up to both in-state and out-of-state tuition for nonresidents). This scholarship covers partial to full tuition for four years.</p>

<i><b>Tiger Marching Band Service Award</b></i>	Award consists of \$1000. Award is based on acceptance into Tiger Band and is give to Instrumentalists, Colorguard and Golden Girls.
